## **GENERAL CLUB RULES AND GUIDELINES**

All Shooters & their guests are required to observe and follow all range safety rules including the Federal Firearms Act. As a firearm owner/user you're responsible for your own actions & the actions of any guest you bring to the facility. Failure to comply with the Act or any club rules may result in expulsion from the facility or termination of membership. The brief list below is a summary, but not limited to other additional rules, posted or verbalized, as well as direction by the RSO.

- 1) All Firearms must be unloaded during transportation around the club, whether walking or riding, including between traps and between posts/stations
- 2) All Firearms are to be pointed down, and down range when on the shooting line
- 3) All Firearms to remain unloaded except when in the designated position on the firing line, and your turn to shoot is imminent
- 4) Keep fingers off the trigger until you are in position and ready to fire
- 5) When changing positions, shooters shall not walk in front of other competitors
- 6) Erratic movement and exposure to adjacent traps should be kept to a minimum
- 7) A Firearms action may be closed while setting guns in the racks, however it must always be unloaded with safety engaged
- 8) The use of Eye and Ear Protection is mandatory on the trap field!
- 9) Shotgun size must be 12gauge or smaller. Ammunition shot size may only be #7-1/2, #8, #8-1/2, or #9 & must be lead. Max speeds of 1290FPS for shot charge of 1-1/8 ounce, Max speeds of 1325 FPS for shot charge of 1 ounce, Max speeds of 1350FPS for shot charge of 7/8 ounce or less. Factory Ammunition is preferred at all E.G.C. Events. The E.G.C. reserves the right to monitor, test, or prohibit any factory or reloaded ammunition at any time during any event including A.T.A. shoots
- 10) Only one (1) shell is permitted in the firearm at a time, and only when it is your turn to shoot. Two (2) shells are permitted while shooting doubles
- 11) Only individuals shooting are allowed on the field, unless they have permission of the range officer prior to the start of the round. At ATA registered Events, only competitors, referees, scorers, or shoot officials may be allowed on a live trap field, unless a safety concern arises.
- 12) No one is allowed forward of the 16 yard line, except staff or authorized personnel
- 13) When the cease-fire flag is raised upon the trap house, or when staff is forward of the 16 yard line, all Firearms must be open and unloaded
- 14) Excepting members of the ATA competing at a registered Event, No one under the age of 18 is allowed to shoot on the trap field without the supervision of a parent, guardian or instructor. The range officer can not be the supervisor
- 15) There shall be no unsupervised children/minors around the range at any time!
- 16) The designated score keeper/pullers are classified as Range Officers and will be in control of the squad at all times
- 17) No one shall discharge a firearm they are not familiar with or capable of operating. The Range Officer has full discretion here whilst tutoring
- 18) Individuals that have not shot trap before must be under supervision by an experienced member, Range Officer, or authorized designate of the club
- 19) The use of Drugs or Alcohol before or during a shoot is strictly forbidden
- 20) All pets must be on a leash, and are not permitted near the firing line or trap fields
- 21) No Rifles or Handguns are allowed on the property!
- 22) There shall be no ammunition sales, vendors or other proprietors on the club property without express permission from the E.G.C.
- 23) All Firearms must be equipped so not to eject spent hulls in a manner that will disrupt other competitors on the line
- 24) Spent hulls that fall on the ground remain the property of the club. Do not pick up.
- 25) Violence, abuse or threatening behavior toward any person on the club property is strictly forbidden. Any such activity is grounds for expulsion from the facility and termination of membership. In the event that this occurs with a guest; the member who brought them may be subject to a membership review & the same consequential punishment

## **CLUB REGISTERED SHOOT INFORMATION**

- \*Please have your average card up to date prior to presenting to classification Committee
- \*Be aware of any new club or ATA rules. ATA Rules will govern all registered events
- \*Be ready to shoot when your squad is called
- \*Check your scores! No changes will be permitted on the score sheet after (5) targets shot except as allowed by ATA Rules
- \*Safe activity and gun handling is expected at all times
- \*It is the shooters' responsibility to ensure their category declaration is on their entry card

### **AMMUNITION**

- \*Ammunition sales are available at the club, & must comply with the Federal Firearms Act
- \*To purchase, you must be a valid P.A.L. holder and present it at time of sale
- \*Only Factory Loaded Ammunition conforming to ATA Rules will be permitted during registered ATA events

### **CLASSIFICATION**

\*All classification will be based on official ATA averages and known ability. All shooters may shoot for their individual classes, but must declare at time of registration for entry into the special categories. \*As there are no Champion Trophies in E.G.C. Cub Registered Shoots, category shooters may choose to shoot off for class trophies without forfeiting their special category status should they lose. This only applies where no category trophies are supplied; All American Points Pins are not considered trophies.

### **SQUADDING**

- \*The club will assign squadding at the time of registration for all events, and we ask all shooters avoid squadding late/early so there is the least possible delay between events
- \*Registration and squadding will remain open as long as reasonably possible for late arrivals. Please notify club management if you know you will be arriving late to the club

### **SHOOT OFFS**

- \*Ties will be decided through shoot-off or carry-over, at the discretion of club management; any resolution flips must be agreed by each shooter
- \*Ties in handicap where movement by one or more shooter is involved, any carry-overs or resolution flips must be agreed by each shooter, or a shoot-off will be required

### **TROPHIES**

- \*Trophies supplied by the Edmonton Gun Club may be Cash or Prizes, and vary from Event to Event; please inquire at time of registration for trophy information.
- \*Trophies Awarded: Singles (4 Classes), Doubles (4 Classes), Handicap (Champ, 2nd, 3rd) and High Over ALL, for events 1 through 6

### **ATTAINMENT PINS**

- \*The E.G.C. will award "100" & "200" Straight Pins upon accomplishment during a club registered event of that target count. If it is your first registered 100 or 200 Straight, the ATA will also award a pin.

### **SPORTSMANSHIP**

- \*Please be courteous to other shooters and refrain from loud boisterous conduct, especially behind shooters competing on the line during long yardage events!

### **NOTICE**

- \*The E.G.C. reserves the right to change this program at any time, and is not responsible for any accident or loss of property, and reserves the right to refuse entry, or disqualify anyone disrupting shoot harmony
- \*Different or Additional Rules may apply to the Alberta Provincial, Canadians, or Western Zone Tournaments, that would supercede the above information

### GRUBSTAKE 50.50

\*The Grubstake Purse is made up of three (3) separate 50 Straight purses in any 100 target registered handicap event. Names have been given to each purse for reference:

\*Traps 1 and 2 make up the first "50"....."Diamond Lil's Purse"

\*Traps 2 and 3 make up the second "50"....."Klondike Mike's Poke"

\*Traps 3 and 4 make up the third "50"....."The Silver Slipper"

\*Entry Fee for the Grubstake is \$9.00CAD. Three dollars are added to each purse. Shooters who break a 50 straight in any of the purses will receive 50% of that purse. The club retains no percentage, and any Ties divide. If there are no 50's recorded, the purse is perpetual and will carry over by shoot & year

### CLUB LEWIS

\*Entry Fee is \$10.00CAD. For every 5 entries, 1 class is formed, there is a 3 Class Limit. The total purse is divided equally among classes; 2 Pays per Class 60%/40% Percentage.

### SPECIAL EVENT

\*Entry fee is \$10.00CAD. Proceeds of entries and 90% of the Auction will form the purse. Purse divided into one money per seven shooters (round to nearest seven) Hi-gun. With Shooter receiving 25%, and the buyer receiving 75%. The 10% of the Auction remaining is retained by the Host Club. Buy-ins will be closed at 3pm on the day of auction.

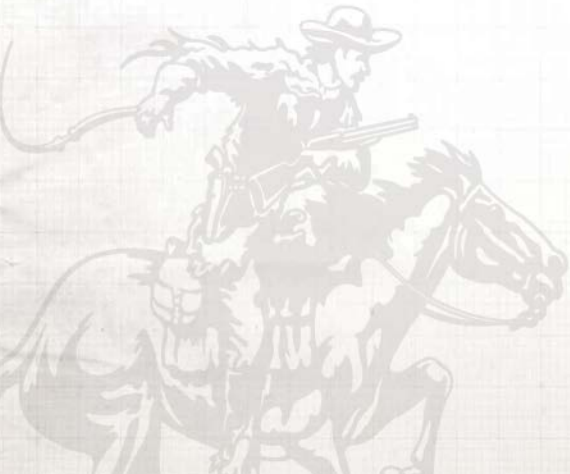

3. **Prices.....** All prices will be set by the Host Club. All Shooters will be charged prevailing ATA and APTA fees . No refunds on targets and trophies, or pre-squad fee, refunds for options only up to the start of the event. 2024 Fees below:

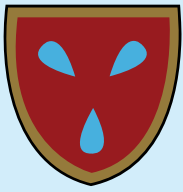

4. **Targets.....** 108mm Orange Dome White Flyer targets will be thrown for all events.
5. **Registration...** Check Individual Events for registration times. Only APTA Directors may classify shooters. Any shooter's classification not signed by a Director will be disqualified.
6. **Scoring.....** All Scoring, Squadding and Calculations will be done with a Shoot Software. Shooters are responsible to check their scores every post change, no corrections will be made outside of tallying errors, strictly within the ATA rules.
7. **Pre-Squad.....** Pre-squadding may be available online at "Pre-Squad.com" fees will apply.
8. **Squadding.....** The Event Coordinators will assign squadding, for those not "Pre-Squadded" online. Please allow enough time before the event to go through handicapping & cashiering. Preferential "late/early" squadding will be avoided, as we expect to operate with the least possible delay between events. Reasonable time will be allowed for registration before entries will be closed. Any Shooter wishing to re-squad, or misses their squad will be charged a one time re-squadding fee of \$20CAD, provided the need for re-squad is not a result or instance where the shoot management is at fault. Any shooters re-squadded will be placed on the same bank as their original squad.
9. **Categories.....** Because All American points will be awarded at this tournament, shooters may declare only one category (i.e. Lady1, Lady 2, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior-Gold, Sub-Vet, Veteran, or Senior Veteran). Chair shooters are exempt from this rule. Category shooters listed above must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashiering for the first event entered.
10. **Shoot Order.....** Singles and Handicap events will be shot 5 targets per post, 25 targets per trap. Doubles will be shot 5 pair per post, 25 pairs per trap.
11. **Banks.....** Targets in any singular event will be shot on one Bank, with Two Traps per Bank.
12. **Make Ups.....** A squad may be held up to five minutes for a tardy shooter. If the tardy shooter does not appear within five minutes, the squad must begin the event without that shooter. Per ATA Rules, if the tardy shooter arrives before the squad fires the first shot on the second post of the first sub-event, the shooter may make-up the first post only and continue with the squad. A shooter will not be allowed to make-up more than 50 targets on the make-up traps. If a tardy shooter is unable to join the squad before the squad has started their third sub-event, the shooter must re-squad for the event. The host club may in its discretion charge a re-squad penalty not exceeding \$25. A shooter will not be permitted to re-squad on a short squad that has commenced the event. All make-ups must be completed by the time the last squad completes the event.
13. **Practice.....** Practice traps will be open during shoot days, 30 minutes prior to the start of any scheduled event. Practice rounds will be at regular Provincial Host Club rates.
14. **Earned Pins.** The APTA will award 100 Straight Pins to shooters scoring 100 in any event of that length, and 200 Straight Pins to shooters scoring 200 in a 200 bird event.

### 15. Class

**Advance.....**Shooters winning or tying for class in any Singles or Doubles events (including at the discretion of the handicap committee, any Preliminary events that are not included in the HOA) will advance at least one class for the next like event. Should you earn yardage in any Handicap event, it is the shooters responsibility to report to an Event Coordinator for yardage punch and any possible squadding revisions resulting in movement. **Western Zones don't include penalty classification or class advances in Singles or Doubles, or penalty yardage in Handicap for any Shooters. Due to limitations of the shoot reporting computer system, a Shooter cannot have different classes or yardages for the two Tournaments. Therefore, Provincial Championship Singles and Doubles classification including penalty classification and Class advances) and Provincial Championship handicap yardage (including penalty yardage) will govern for Shooters participating in these Tournaments**

**16. Shoot-Offs.....**No Shoot-Offs or Carry overs for Wednesdays Doubles, Preliminary Singles and Doubles Ties will carry over to the next like sub-event where possible. Handicap & Championship Ties will be shot-off as per ATA rules. Shooters are responsible for determining whether they are in a shoot-off and to report timely or forfeit. Shoot-offs will be based on 25 targets for Singles and Handicap; 10 pair for Doubles; 20 Singles, 10 Handicap and 5 pair Doubles for HAA; and, 20 Singles, 20 Handicap and 5 pair Doubles for HOA events. **Western Zone Events on Friday will be carried over to Championship events. 100/200 Straights in the Championship Events will immediately bank targets in 25 or 10-pair sub-events and repeated if necessary. Target proportions for HOA will be determined by the Zone.**

**17. Youth Rates.** Resident Junior Classes are exempt from Target/Trophy fees for the entirety of the Provincial Tournament, provided Purses or Options are not played. (Special Event is Excluded). ATA /APTA Memberships, Daily/Event Fees and Insurances must be paid.

**18. Trophies.....**Provincial Trophies will be awarded as per the Trophy List provided below each event. Category shooters are eligible for Class trophies during all Preliminary events, where no Category trophy is supplied. Unclaimed trophies will be recycled. Western Zone Trophies will be sent to winners directly from the trophy vendor.

**19. Closed Ties..**Champion, Category, Place, Class, and Yardage Fall backs as per ATA Rules Section XD. Where multiple Class Resident Shooters tie with the highest score in an event featuring Open and Closed trophies, a shoot off will determine the winner of Closed Champion. Second place will take Closed Runner Up.

**20. Etiquite.....**Please show courtesy to other shooters by refraining from loud or boisterous conduct while behind shooters still competing on the firing line, especially during the handicap events. Your cooperation is appreciated. The APTA and Provincial shoot management also reserve the right to disqualify, or refuse entry to any person/s or shooter/s who interfere with or disturb the harmony of the shoot in any manner, or modify/cancel/revise any aspect of the event if necessary.

**21. Grievances...**Because the Provincial Championship tournament is hosted by a club, The APTA Board of Directors has therefore struck a committee consisting of the ATA Delegate and two others to be appointed by the APTA to be responsible for handling all shooter grievances at the tournament. Shooters with grievances should contact one of the committee members, identified in the Duty Roster section of this Program.

**22. Changes.....**Every effort has been made to ensure that information in this Program is accurate and complete, however shoot management reserves the right to alter or cancel any part of this program at any time and for any reason, and are not bound by errors or omissions. Any changes and/or corrections posted at the registration table/scoreboard area will supersede the information in this program.

**23. Amenities...** For all other information such as Camping, Pets, Golf Carts, Solicitation and Vendors, please refer to the Host Club portion of this program and/or posted Club advertising and operational rules. We hope you have a fantastic shoot!

## CLASSIFICATION HANDICAPPING

Classification will be based on official averages and known ability. In all cases, known ability will have a strong bearing on classification. The APTA reserves the authority to change the classification of any shooter at any time and the additional authority through proper channels with the ATA to make any yardage change they deem necessary. APTA Board of Directors are the Classification and Handicap Committee for this Shoot. Any shooter whose classification is not signed by an APTA Director will be disqualified. Shooters are required to have their 16-yard and doubles averages computed prior to registration. Shooters who present an average card without all targets recorded and/or without averages being calculated will not be classified until the card is completed.

### PENALTY CLASSIFICATION AND YARDAGE

- Singles.....**A shooter who has less than 1000 total 16 yard targets registered for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" class or higher at the discretion of the APTA Director classifying the shooter. At the discretion of the handicap committee, a shooter's Class may be adjusted if target minimums are met during the tournament.
- Doubles....**A shooter who has less than 1000 total doubles targets registered for the current and previous two years will be assigned to "B" class or higher at the discretion of the APTA Director classifying the shooter. At the discretion of the handicap committee, a shooter's Class may be adjusted if target minimums are met during the tournament.
- Handicap..**A shooter will shoot his or her ATA or PITA yardage, whichever is the longest. However if the shooter has not shot PITA targets in the current or preceding ATA target year and has been granted a reduction after an ATA 1,000 target review, the shooter will shoot from his or her ATA yardage. Shooters 70 years of age or older and have less than 1000 total handicap targets registered for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or average card yardage, whichever is longer. Assigned yardage will be no less than 20 yards. All other shooters who have less than 1000 total Handicap targets registered for the current and previous two years will shoot from assigned yardage or average card yardage, whichever is longer Assigned yardage will be no less than 23 yards. Yardage may be re-classified if minimums are met during the tournament subject to restrictions.

Subject to penalty classification, the following classification table will be used for this Prov/Zone:

### NOTICE TO SPECIAL CATEGORY SHOOTERS

Because All American points will be awarded at this tournament, shooters may declare only one category (I.e. Lady1, Lady 2, Sub-Junior, Junior, Junior Gold, Sub-Vet, Veteran, or Senior Veteran). Chair shooters are exempt from this rule. Category shooters listed above must declare their special category at the time of classification in order to be eligible for special category trophies. It is the responsibility of special category shooters to ensure that their special category has been noted on their entry form prior to cashing for the first event entered.

Any Category Shooter tied for event Champion may shoot-off/carry over for the Championship Trophy. If the Category shooter fails in the trophy shoot-off/carry over, they will fall back to the declared Category. Closed Runner-up and closed Category winners may not fall back to Open Champion. All other qualifying closed Category shooters may fall back in the following order: Open Champion, Closed Class, Open Class. In an event that has no Champion Trophy, the Category shooter whose score qualifies for a trophy in their declared Category, may not fall back to place, or class. Where there is no Category Trophy offered, the Category shooter is eligible to shoot for Class or place trophies without forfeiting their special Category status should they lose. Any Category Shooter whose score does not qualify for a trophy in their category, may compete for place, or class trophies. Once declarations of Category have been made by the shooter or shoot management, the declaration is final and cannot be changed. There shall be no exception to this rule.

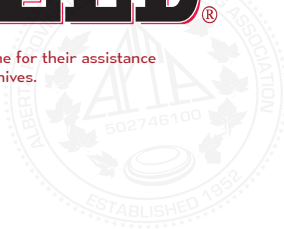
